

The country may have spent the weekend commemorating an unsuccessful Catholic conspiracy to overthrow the monarchy but the gathering of Catholic gentlemen at the Mercure Dolphin on Monday wisely kept their discourse to less 'incendiary' plotting!

It may have been an ordinary Circle meeting but, amid the fun of the fireworks and the bonfire parties, this November anniversary also marks a passage in English history when our Catholic ancestors suffered cruel penalties for gathering in the name of their Faith. That Circles of Catenian men can now openly come together in fraternity as the Southampton Circle did on Monday, as well as celebrating with families and friends at public Masses, is a testament to how far our country has travelled along the road to religious harmony since the 1600s.

Our Circle meetings may not plot anything more dangerous than a change in dress code but Catenian brothers can find within the story of the Gunpowder Plot a commonality in the strong bond of Catholic brotherhood. Opinion may vary on the explosive intentions of Catesby and company but the letter to the Jacobean Catholic MP, advising him to stay away from Parliament on 5 November 1605, is believed by most historians to have genuinely arisen out of concern by at least one of the conspirators for his brothers in Faith. The sense of fellowship was not reciprocated and the letter was passed into the hands of the King's Council. But this aspect of the story displays a bond between Catholic men that has endured and forms the basis of the Catenian friendship today.

Please advise Bro. David Palmer if you wish to attend the Christmas lunch. There is a restricted number so book early to avoid disappointment.


MASS FOR DECEASED BROTHERS
