OUR SECOND PILGRIMAGE TO LOURDES by Folkert & Wilma





Since 1901 the Catholic Association (CA) of England and Wales has organised pilgrimages to Lourdes. This 124th pilgrimage was our second. Such a pilgrimage is a massive movement of people, of sick and disabled pilgrims, their helpers and carers and the clergy that wishes to support them. In all, over 300 people took off to Lourdes by aeroplane and on the Jumbulance bus, which drove more dependent-assisted pilgrims there.

We had a very good week. Renewing contacts with people we met last year and meeting new people. Folkert helped out as a 'brancardier', and Wilma was part of the medical team again. As much as possible we took part in the events and programme organised by the pilgrimage. Because it is a big group, we often have our own church services. You can see other people walking in (and often out again) who come on their own and do not really know where to go. This year we were given the honour of leading the candlelight procession in the evening.







This time we got a better idea about the involvement of young people in the pilgrimage. Many come from Catholic schools in the country, and it gives them an opportunity to meet each other, to help out with the assisted Pilgrims, and to come to a place where faith is openly shown. Some of them really need support in paying for the trip. The CA can provide some help with this, but as a charity itself it needs to generate income. Some organise their own fundraising. We wondered if Catenians would consider assisting in the future as well with support for this pilgrimage and especially for young people? 
